STUDENT CRITERIA for 2024 SCCMC MEMORIAL BURSARY

Bursary Objectives

The SCCMC Memorial Bursary is focused on local Chinese history and research that can help to cultivate cohesion and advance multiculturalism by empowering young people from diverse backgrounds to engage in a shared exploration and celebration of the local Chinese culture and history. By offering financial support and recognition for research projects on local history, this competition encourages young people to work together, learn from each other, and build bridges of understanding and respect. This in turn, brings people from different backgrounds together to appreciate and celebrate the rich cultural heritage of their community.

Application Entries

Application opens on Tuesday 18 June 2024 and closes at 4pm on Wednesday 28 August 2024.

Theme

The presence of Chinese history, through the telling of the best local story of a person or family with Chinese heritage, in St George (or Balonne Shine Council).

Categories

The submission entries in any one of these mediums is acceptable:

- Writing a short story with no more than 200 words, or
- Provide a Pictorial of your story on a single side, A3 sized paper, or
- Provide a collage of photos of your story on a single side, A3 sized paper.

For this application for bursaries, one entry is allowed per person.

Judging Panel Members

The judging panel will be comprised of the following people:

- SCCMC Chairperson
- SCCMC Bursary Chairperson
- Sunnybank RSL representative
- Academia representative
- Major sponsor of SCCMC

Bursary Awards

One SCCMC Memorial Bursary awarded to each of 3 categories is \$500.

Judging criteria

- 1. Creativity and originality:
 - Novelty and uniqueness of the idea or approach

- Creativity and originality in execution and presentation
- Demonstration of research and review of historical information
- 2. Diversity and inclusion:
 - Consideration of diversity and inclusion in the subject matter or theme
 - Promotion of tolerance and understanding of different cultures, beliefs, and perspectives
 - Demonstration of a commitment to creating a more inclusive society
- 3. Composition and storytelling:
 - Effective use of composition, including elements such as framing, lighting, and color
 - Clear and engaging storytelling through visual or written narrative
 - Demonstration of a strong sense of narrative or theme throughout the work

Terms and condition of the Application for SCCMC Bursary

- 1. Eligibility: The Bursary is open to all current students of St George State High School, from Year 7-Year 12.
- 2. Application process: The application process for the bursary award must be completed by the stated deadline and may require the submission of additional documentation.
- 3. Selection process: The selection process for the bursary award will be based on specific criteria outlined by the Bursary organisers. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 4. Award amount: The bursary award amount will be determined by the Bursary organisers and may have certain conditions or restrictions.
- 5. Contact information: Contact information for the Bursary organisers will be provided for inquiries or assistance with the application process.
- 6. Publicity: The Bursary organisers reserve the right to publicise the Recipients of the SCCMC Memorial Bursary and their accomplishments in connection with the bursary awards.
- 7. Disqualification: Any applicant found to have violated the terms and conditions of the Bursary Application may be disqualified from consideration.
- 8. Changes to the terms and conditions: The Bursary organisers reserve the right to make changes to the terms and conditions of the Bursary Application at any time.
- 9. Liability: The Bursary organisers are not responsible for any damages or losses that may result from participation in the Application.
- 10. Confidentiality: The Bursary organisers will keep all personal information submitted by applicants confidential and will only use it for the purpose of administering the Bursary Application.
